Baptism Site:

Mount Nebo:

The Holy Land – The place where Moses is said to have glimpsed upon the Holy Land before settling in his final resting place. The breathtaking views and spiritual significance of this site are truly spectacular.

Madaba:

A Historic City of Mosaics - renowned for its captivating "Mosaic of Jerusalem", one of the oldest pictorial representations of the Holy City. If the sky is clear, you will have a wonderful view up from the mountain seeing the Jordan Valley, the Dead Sea, and Jericho in the other bank of the Jordan River.
